

Overview

As a Business Analyst at BARDD you will play a key role supporting and guiding organisations to success in transformation, cultural change and complex delivery. You will be a major contributor to business and functional requirements and will work with a delivery team to define and prioritise outcomes. You will need to be a strong written and oral communicator and able to work under pressure.

Key Functions

- Analyse and evaluate the structure and processes of an organisation to determine how it operates
- Engage with stakeholders to undertake functional and non-functional requirements capture and analysis, ensuring they are complete and unambiguous
- Validate requirements to ensure they map to business needs, are approved by appropriate stakeholders and they meet with required quality standards
- Identify problems and areas for improvement and optimisation with the current business model and where appropriate support design of a target operating model
- Design potential solutions or improvements to business problems
- Document and report findings with associated risk and impact assessments
- Communicate insights and plans to team members, client management and non-technical stakeholders
- Design and run training sessions and workshops to support relevant teams
- Develop and manage comprehensive end-to-end test cases for user acceptance
- Oversee the implementation of approved process improvements
- Define and oversee quality assurance
- Support programme and project implementation and transition to business as usual
